#### **Judges 1 :28**

When Israel became strong, they pressed the Canaanites into forced labor but never drove them out completely.

#### **Judges 2 :18**

Whenever the Lord raised up a judge for them, he was with the judge and saved them out of the hands of their enemies as long as the judge lived; for the Lord relented because of their groaning under those who oppressed and afflicted them.

#### **Judges 3 :4**

They were left to test the Israelites to see whether they would obey the Lord's commands, which he had given their ancestors through Moses.

#### **Judges 4 :15**

At Barak's advance, the Lord routed Sisera and all his chariots and army by the sword, and Sisera got down from his chariot and fled on foot.

#### **Judges 5 :5**

The mountains quaked before the Lord, the One of Sinai, before the Lord, the God of Israel.

#### **Judges 6 :17**

Gideon replied, "If now I have found favor in your eyes, give me a sign that it is really you talking to me.

#### **Judges 7 :2**

The Lord said to Gideon: You have too many men. I cannot deliver Midian into their hands, or Israel would boast against me, 'My own strength has saved me.'

#### **Judges 8 :28**

Thus, Midian was subdued before the Israelites and did not raise its head again. During Gideon's lifetime, the land had peace forty years.

#### **Judges 9**

#### **Judges 10 :10**

Then the Israelites cried out to the Lord, "We have sinned against you, forsaking our God and serving the Baals."

**Judges 11 :21**

“Then the Lord, the God of Israel, gave Sihon and his whole army into Israel’s hands, and they defeated them. Israel took over all the land of the Amorites who lived in that country.

**Judges 12 :3a**

When I saw that you wouldn’t help, I took my life in my hands and crossed over to fight the Ammonites, and the Lord gave me the victory over them.

**Judges 13: 3 – 4**

The angel of the Lord appeared to her and said, “You are barren and childless, but you are going to become pregnant and give birth to a son. Now see to it that you drink no wine or other fermented drink and that you do not eat anything unclean.

**Judges 14 :6a**

The Spirit of the Lord came powerfully upon him so that he tore the lion apart with his bare hands as he might have torn a young goat.

**Judges 15 : 19a**

Then God opened up the hollow place in Lehi, and water came out of it. When Samson drank, his strength returned, and he revived.

**Judges 16**

**Judges 17 :6**

In those days Israel had no king; everyone did as they saw fit.

**Judges 18 :5-6**

Then they said to him, “Please inquire of God to learn whether our journey will be successful.” The priest answered them, “Go in peace. Your journey has the Lord’s approval.”

**Judges 19 :23b**

“No, my friends, don’t be so vile. Since this man is my guest, don’t do this outrageous thing.

**Judges 21 :2**

The people went to Bethel,[a] where they sat before God until evening, raising their voices and weeping bitterly.
